The event is held under the auspices of the Deputy Mayor of the City of Ostrava and subsidized by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic and the Association of University Technical Sports in the Czech Republic.

General provisions

Organizer: The Student Club of Fire Sports in cooperation with VSB-TU Ostrava and its

Faculty of Safety Engineering, and also with Association of Firefighters of Bohemia, Moravia and Silesia, Fire Rescue Service of the Moravian-Silesian Region, the Association of University Technical Sports in the Czech

Republic, and the City of Ostrava.

Educational

institutions: all universities, colleges from the Czech Republic and abroad, and the three

best-rated secondary schools (or teams) from the Secondary School Championship in Fire Sport of the Czech Republic. If one of the top three schools refuses to participate, the school that ended in the following order may participate. Moreover, schools that received an invitation form the

organizer can also attend.

Contestants: university student, advance vocational school student (full-time or combined

study) and secondary school student (according to the requirements see

"Educational Institutions" as required).

Technical provisions

University students start under the heading of the university, or possibly college or secondary school, not the faculty. The only exception is faculties with detached workplaces outside their own universities, which are allowed to start independently for faculties. These include Charles University in Pilsen, Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové (jointly called UK Hradec Králové) and the University of Economics in Prague - Faculty of Management in Jindřichův Hradec.

Disciplines by category:

men

100 m race with obstacles 4 x 100 m relay race with obstacles climbing to the 4th floor of the training tower

fire attack (3B)

women

100 m race with obstacles
4 x 100 m relay race with
obstacles
climbing to the 2nd floor of the
training tower

Rules:

All disciplines will follow the rules of fire sport effective in the Czech Republic (https://www.hzscr.cz/clanek/predpisy-a-pravidla). The organizer reserves the right to adjust the rules for the number of competitors in the disciplines and for the overall evaluation.

The best-ranked contestant and team representing a university in the Czech Republic will be awarded the title "Academic Champion of the Czech Republic in Fire Sport".

Technical conditions:

- material for the 100 m race with obstacles individual,
- for the 4 x 100 m relay race with obstacles and ascent to the tower ladders can be rented by appointment. It must be reported by 26 April 2020 to email: kristyna.kutilova@outlook.cz,
- the runway surface tartan, grass with the interlocking pavement starting point for fire attack.
- the Fire Rescue Service of the Moravian-Silesian Region will provide electronic timekeeping,
- during the 4 x 100 m relay race with obstacles, a fire extinguisher is carried on the fourth section.
- during the fire attack, uniform material supplied by the organizer shall be used,
- the equipment is inspected at random according to the rules of fire sport effective in the Czech Republic.

Information on the number of competitors per discipline: men women

4 x 100 m relay race with obstacles
 Competitors can only run in one relay.
 Ex. 7 competitors can only form 1 relay.

Attempts:



- in the disciplines running 100 m with obstacles and climbing to the 4th (or 2nd) floor of the training tower, each competitor has the possibility of two attempts,
- in the discipline climbing to the 2nd floor of the training tower in the women category, the competitor will only climb to the second floor (the first window), and the ladder for the climb will be hung on the second-floor ledge before the start of the attempt (a woman competitor with a ladder will not start from the starting line).
- in the fire attack discipline, the team will have **one** attempt.
- each educational institution can be represented by **the min. of 1 and max. of 10 competitors** in one category (women, men). Only a male person can compete in the men category. In the women category, only a female person can compete.

Measuring time:

For all disciplines, the electronic timekeeping will be lent by the Fire Rescue Service of the Moravian-Silesian Region.

Protests:

The protest can be made according to the rules of the fire sport after paying the security deposit of CZK 200.00 to the referee, to whom the written protest or appeal is handed over (see the rules of fire sport effective in the Czech Republic).

Evaluation

The evaluation of individual disciplines is identical with the rules of fire sport effective in the Czech Republic.

Estimated time schedule of the competition:

The opening ceremony of the championship will take place on 29 April 2020 at 11:00 a.m.

The award ceremony will take place on 30 April 2020 at 2:00 p.m.

The start of the disciplines on each day of the championship will be between 8:00 - 9:00 p.m.

A detailed timetable will be posted on the website after the contest applications have been completed. The organizer draws attention to the possibility of changing the schedule of the competition, depending on the number of registered competitors and other circumstances.

Provisions for the competition days

Registration of competitors:

Only the team leader of the educational institution will come to register the competitors on the day of the competition. He/she will submit the completed application form with the signatures of the competitors and the signature and stamp of the applicant organization. Only properly registered and marked competitors with a helmet on their heads are allowed on the racetrack.

Parking:

The vehicles will be allowed to enter the premises only during the time of checking the attendance for the import and unloading of the material and after the end of the competition day for the transport and loading of the material. Parking of vehicles will be possible in the car parks around the premises (see the plan below).
